3. NCN4

- Clive had discussed towpath issues with the Canal and River Trust and Sustrans, but neither party had funds for additional repairs.
- CRT confirmed that they would only cut back vegetation once per year from now on.
- It was suggested that Spokes could ask for volunteers to help with cutting back vegetation and could approach CRT and Sustrans volunteers regarding CT / PR joint working.
- Surfacing improvements were underway on the section to the east of Aldermaston Wharf.

West Berkshire Council Cycle Schemes 4.

- Pangbourne to Purley Cycle Route:
 - The Council was liaising with landowners along the proposed route.
- Burghfield to Mortimer Cycle Route:
 - A planning application had been submitted and the parish council was looking for funding.
- A339 Kings Road:
 - Measures were being introduced to make it clear that the eastern

footway was not designated for shared use.

Improved signing was being provided along the west side and Cheap
 Street to highlight the proper cycle route.

A4 Crown Mead:

- The design was about to go out to consultation.
- Utility diversion costs were extremely high, so the current proposal was only for an on-carriageway cycle lane in each direction.
- The Council recognised that the design was a compromise and did not achieve best practice design.

A343 Andover Road:

 The traffic order for the double yellow lines to prevent parking in the on-carriageway cycle lane was in a list of schemes still to be processed.

5. Cycle Count

- The June counts had been completed as planned.
- Rob to provide an analysis of the data.
- It was agreed that it would be good to circulate the results to the wider membership.
